Single grape and premium quality red wine from Terra Alta DOP

About the vintage:

Climate characterization from October 2016 to September 2017
Average temperature: 16.1° C, with a particularly warm and dry spring
Rain: 391 mm, one ¼ of which fall during June and July
Dates of the vintage: the earliest in history, August 30th, 2017

Elaboration

Selected and harvested by hand vineyards. Fermented in stainless steel bat and aged during 6 months in 300 and 225 L French oak barrels.
Volumetric alcoholic degree: 14.3% Vol.
Total acidity: 4.9 grams / l, expressed in tartaric acid
Total sugars: 0.3 grams / l
Bottled date: October 2018
Production: 3,977 bottles x 750 ml
Stopper: natural cork 44 x 24 mm
