

## Laquarta red old vines 2018

### Style:

Single grape and premium quality red wine from Terra Alta DOP  
Aged wine.

### Vineyards:

Variety: "Peluda" Grenache. This is the indigenous Grenache from Ebro River Valley

Surface area: 9.8 ha

Vineyard's age: 33 years old

Traditional growing system

Location:

- Bot: 11 plots
- Gandesa, Cendrosa batch: 2 plots

Major type of soil: limestone, frank texture and clay loam

Harvest yield: 2.607 kg/ha

### About the vintage:

Climate characterization from October 2017 to September 2018

Average temperature: 14.6° C, with a particularly cool spring and a very hot and dry summer

Rain: 411 mm. Frequent but not generous rains during the spring season.

Dates of the vintage: September 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>

### Elaboration

Selected and harvested by hand vineyards. Fermented in stainless steel bat and aged during 5 months in 300 and 225 L French oak barrels.

Volumetric alcoholic degree: 14.5% Vol.

Total acidity: 5.35 grams / l, expressed in tartaric acid

Total sugars: <0.5 grams / l

Bottled date: September 2019

Production: 7,239 bottles x 750 ml

Stopper: natural cork 44 x 24 mm
