Climate characterization from October 2016 to September 2017
Average temperature: 16.1° C, with a particularly warm and dry spring

Elaboration

Selected and harvested by hand vineyards. Fermentation and aging on lees for 4 months in stainless steel tanks.
Volumetric alcoholic degree: 13.8% Vol.
Total acidity: 5.1 grams / l, expressed in tartaric acid
Total sugars: 0.22 grams / l
Bottled date: March 2018
Production: 5,500 750 ml bottles
Stopper: natural cork 44 x 24 mm
Minimum bottle aging time: 6 months
