

Llàgrimes de tardor rosé 2020

Mediterranean dry rosé

Viticulture

Region: Terra Alta, Southern Catalonia PDO: DO Terra Alta

Grapes: Red Grenache, Grenache Blanc and *Peluda* Grenache from selected vineyards

Vineyard's age: 33 years old

Growing and conduction system: conventional agriculture, mostly dry grove and traditional system

About 2020 vintage

Harvest yield: 4.522 kg/ha.

Local weather from October to September: 15.2° average temperature and 787 mm of rain per square metre. Harvest with abundant rain mainly in autumn, winter and spring. High relative humidity during spring and part of the summer but lower than 60% during ripening period. Higher than average production although the grapes had an optimal health condition.

Elaboration

Harvest date: September 2nd, manual

Vinification: The three grape varieties are pressed together. This wine is elaborated only from free-run juice after a very short skin contact maceration with a strict control of the temperature during fermentation process.

Bottling date: March 2021

Production: 2.700 bot. 750 ml

Stopper: micro granulated with natural cork washers (type 1+1) 44 x 24 mm

Alcohol content: 13.47 % by Vol.

Total acidity: 5.2 g/l expressed in tartaric acid

Total sugar: <0.5 g/l

Tasting notes: It shows an orange pale and bright colour. On the nose, it is fruity but fine and complex. Well balanced, fresh and lingering taste.

Storage and serving suggestions

Under good storage conditions, this wine will preserve its characteristics during the next 2 years after bottling date (September 2022). Serve at 8°-10° C.
