

Llàgrimes de tardor white 2019

Style

Aged white Terra Alta PDO wine. Dry, full bodied and complex

Viticulture

Region: Terra Alta, Southern Catalonia

Grapes: 100% Grenache Blanc from selected vineyards

Vineyard's age: 35 years old

Growing and conduction system: conventional agriculture, mostly dry grove and traditional system

About 2019 vintage

Harvest yield: 3.849 kg/ha.

Local weather from October 2018 to September 2019: 14.9° average temperature and 436 mm of rain. Moderate winter and a cool spring. Hot temperatures during June, with historic maximum temperatures and low humidity. Although, the excellent Grenache's adaptation and a moderate climate on September allowed a good ripening of the grapes. Most of the rain fall mainly in autumn. A dry harvest.

Elaboration

Harvest: 30th August to 5th September, selected and picked by hand

Elaboration: Skin contact maceration, first half of alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel vat and second half in oak barrels.

Aging: 9 months in barrels with its lees

Oak quality: French new barrels of 225 & 300 L

Bottling date: July 2020

Production: 12.019 bot. 750 ml

Stopper: natural cork 44 x 24 mm

Analytics

Alcohol content: 13.94 % by Vol.

Total acidity: 5.9 g/l expressed in tartaric acid.

Total sugar: <0.5 g/l

Suggestions

Under good storage conditions, this wine will preserve its characteristics until the 5th year (2024).

Best served at 12° C / 54° F
