

## Llàgrimes de tardor white 2021

### Style

Aged white Terra Alta PDO wine. Dry, full bodied and complex

### Viticulture

Region: Terra Alta, Southern Catalonia

Grapes: 100% Grenache Blanc from selected vineyards

Vineyard's age: 37 years old

Growing and conduction system: conventional agriculture, mostly dry grove and traditional system

### About 2021 vintage

Harvest yield: 5.458 kg/ha. Local weather from October 2020 to September 2021: 14.9° average temperature and 487 mm of rainfall. 2021 was an atypical vintage that caused a late ripening of the grapes and a high productive yield. Most of the rainfalls took place during autumn and winter. Also, there was a great snowfall in January. Spring was cool and with little rain, which moderated the vegetative development of the vines. There was a dry summer too, highlighting very hot temperature in mid-August that didn't have significant negative effects on vines. September was slightly warm and wet with abundant rains, which affected our rhythm of harvest and forced us to intensify the grape selection work

### Elaboration

Harvest: 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> September, selected and picked by hand

Elaboration: Skin contact maceration, first half of alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel vat and second half in oak barrels. Exclusively finned with vegetable origin products

Aging: 9 months in barrels with its lees

Oak quality: French new barrels of 225 & 300 L

Bottling date: July 2022

Production: 15.540 bot. 750 ml

Stopper: natural cork 44 x 24 mm

### Analytics

Alcohol content: 13.86 % by Vol.

Total acidity: 5.4 g/l expressed in tartaric acid.

Total sugar: <0.7 g/l

### Suggestions

Under good storage conditions, this wine will preserve its characteristics until 2026. Best served at 12° C / 54° F
